



## Commitments

- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to seek God by starting the day at the ALTAR in prayer with a single purpose: "He must become greater; I must become less." (John 3:30)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to regularly seek God at the ALTAR through prayer, confession of sins, and study of His Word. Do this in order to recognize the voice of Christ and know Him, for this is eternal life. (John 10:4,14,21; 17:3)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to offer self at the ALTAR and study God's Word and allow Him to transform by His Word. Commit to spend time each week listening to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Submit to His work to convict through the Word and be conformed into the image of Christ. (Romans 8:29; 12:1,2)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to seek God by "walking as Jesus did," and putting Him first in every area of life: family, church, friendships, career, entertainment, etc... (1 John 2:5-6). Seek opportunities in these areas to serve and reach others.
- \_\_\_\_\_ As a family, commit to seek God by gathering regularly at the ALTAR for a devotional time. In this time, commit to read the word, pray for the church, elders, ministers, and the healing of the nation and the world.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to seek God by positively participating in corporate worship assemblies, classes, and online offerings. (Hebrews 10:24-26)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to seek God by willingly giving weekly of finances to the Lord's work as He has prospered.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to seek God by displaying the fruit of the Spirit, a Spirit of unity, building others up in the name of Christ and not tearing down or complaining. (John 17; Ephesians 4)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to BLESS at least three people (at least one of which is not a member at Greenwood Park) weekly through calls, visits, cards, e-mails, texts, acts of service, etc.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Commit to submit to the authority of the elders as they keep watch as "men who must give account." Do this so that their work may be a "joy and not a burden." (Hebrews 13:17)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Make these commitments solemnly and joyfully, believing that they will result in the formation of a lifestyle that will forever altar (alter) personal life, family, the church, the community, the nation, and the world.
